



Items Needed

Crate: A medium (approx. 36") crate should be perfect for your pup. It will be a little large at first, but as your pup grows, it will be the perfect size.

Dog Bed: You can choose to purchase a dog bed that will fit inside the crate or use a soft flannel blanket.

Stuffed Animal: We do everything we can to prepare your pup for life without his/her siblings, however, expect some separation anxiety, especially at night. Placing a stuff animal in their crate with them often helps.

Food Bowl & Water Bowls: You will need a bowl for the puppy's food and water. Puppies should have access to water 24 hours a day.

Collar & Leash: Small collar size for your puppy.

Baby Safety Gate: if you have an area you want to prevent access to your pup, a baby gate works perfectly.

Grooming: A Slicker Brush is recommended for your puppy. It is also best to use gentle dog shampoo for at home baths. We recommend towel drying and then letting them air dry.

Toys: Small or medium dog toy, stuffed dog toys with squeakers, ball (tennis or squeaky rubber balls) or rope toys all work great.

Puppy Food: we recommend a quality dog food such as Royal Canin, Nutrena, Purina, or Iams.

Bell for Door: any craft bell or dog training bell can be used for house training.
